

Student Ticketing Regulations

Purpose: To accurately allocate and monitor the distribution of tickets for on-campus events.

Registered North Carolina A&T State University students can purchase and are eligible to receive a **FREE** ticket for most regular season home basketball and football games, as well as select student events based on availability. For up-to-date game schedules, visit www.ncataggies.com.

Ticket Purchase Process:

Students MUST use the online ticketing process for football, basketball, and select student events. To get started, click on the "Tickets" icon/link in the Quick Links tab on www.ncataggies.com. You will be redirected to **TICKET CENTRAL** where you should click on the "Student Account" tab.

Sign into the Student Ticket Hub using your OneID as your username and "password" as your password.

Note: If you want to change your password, click on the "Account Information" tab after signing into the Student Ticket Hub. If you forget your password, select the "Forgot Password" link.

Students must complete the sales process—checkout and submission payment (even if no payment is due)—until you reach the confirmation page. Once you see the confirmation screen, you have finished your reservation. Please click on the "My Tickets" prompt once it appears, or you can click on "Your Tickets" under the Menu option. Event Entry:

Football: After reserving a ticket to your phone students can enter the stadium using any permitted entrance. Game Zone entrances open 5 hours prior to kickoff, and stadium entrances open 1.5 hours prior to kickoff.

Basketball: After reserving a ticket, print or save the ticket to your phone. Students can enter Corbett Sports Arena using any permitted entrance. Doors open 1 hour prior to tip-off.

Student Events: Select tickets for events (e.g., Aggie Fest/Homecoming) are available online. Reserve tickets in the same way as for football and basketball games.



Please Note: Not all student events have free admission.

Online Student Ticket Allotment and Seating:

Student admission to football and basketball games is available on a first-come, firstserved basis. Student tickets are for general admission seating only. Once student allotments have been distributed, students may purchase a general admission ticket at a reduced rate.

Improper Sale or Distribution of Student Tickets:

Violations of these rules or other student ticketing policies may result in a student being referred to the Dean of Students.

Student tickets are available only for eligible N.C. A&T students. If you cannot attend an athletic event, you can cancel your ticket reservation on the Student Ticket Hub by clicking the "Cancellations" tab. The ticket holder's Aggie OneCard must be presented with each student ticket for validity. Transferring tickets for on-campus student events is prohibited on the Student Ticket Hub.

The North Carolina A&T Ticket Office does not authorize the resale of tickets for any on-campus student events.

Students are prohibited from obtaining student tickets by any means other than the established processes.
